



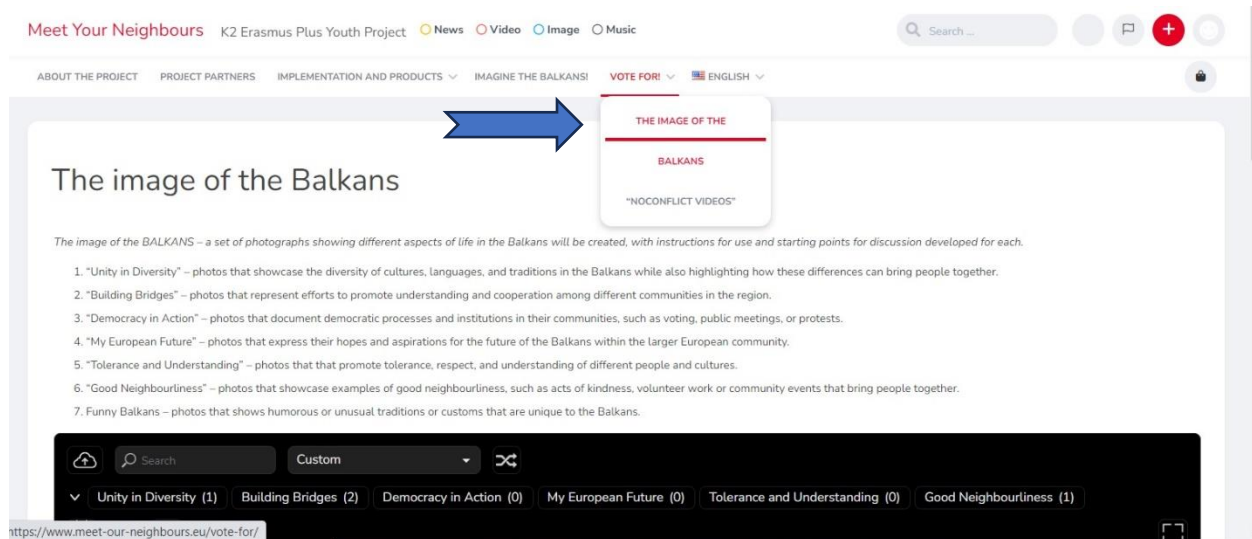

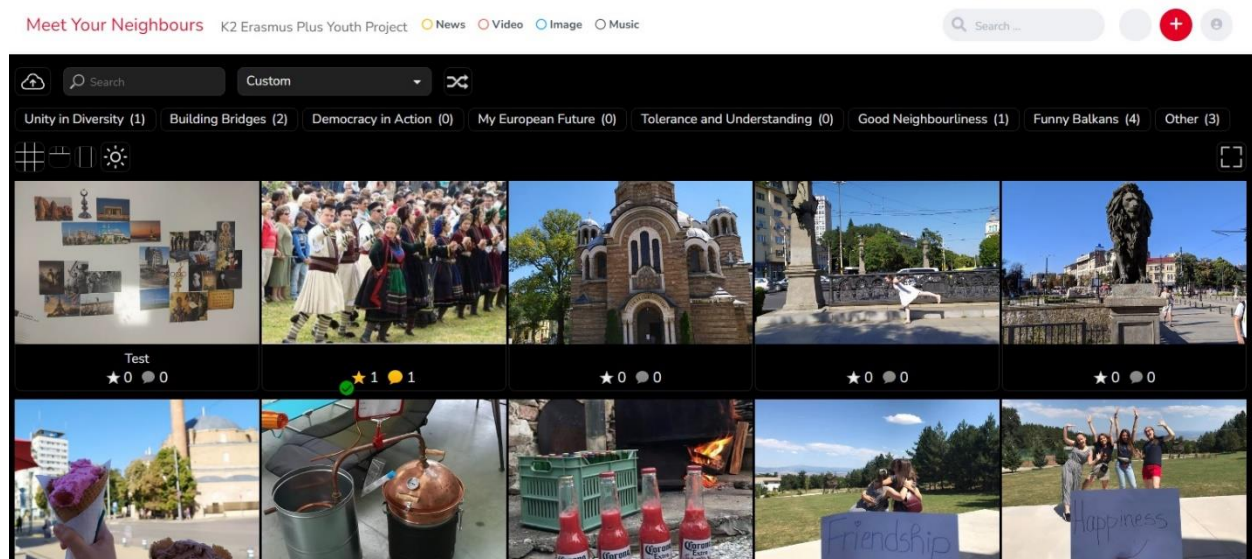

A short guide on how you can participate in the photo contest "The image of the Balkans"

1. First, let's show where on the project's webpage the link to the project is located:



2. When you enter the menu, you will be taken to the contest page. It looks like this:



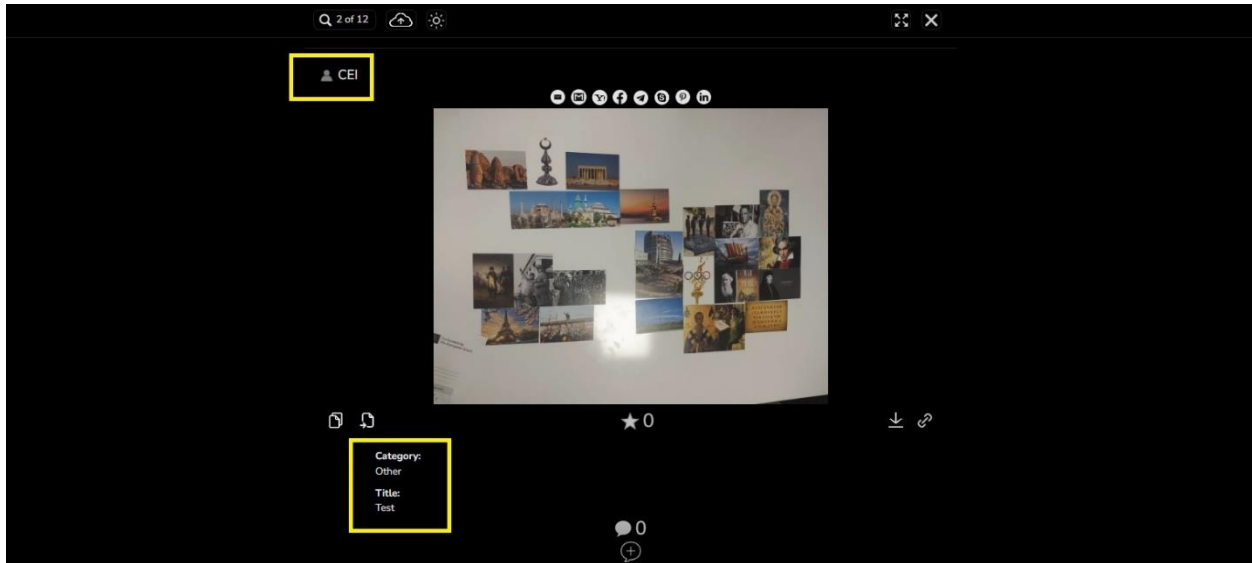

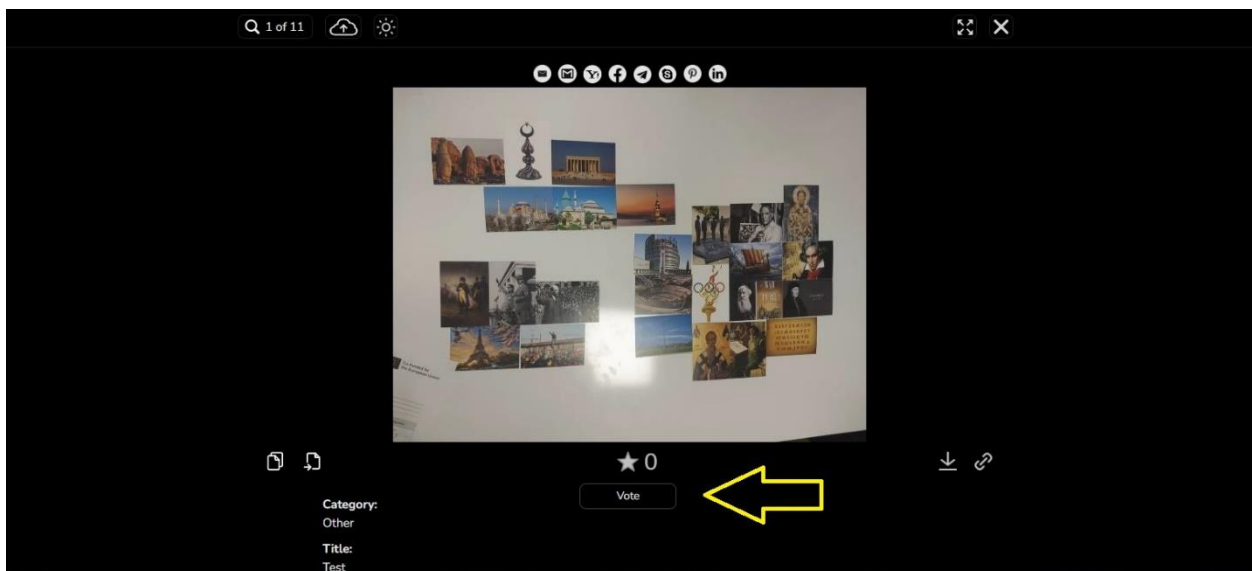

3. When you click on a photo, a screen will open up where you'll see the photo, the **Name** of the person who uploaded it labeled at the top, and below that the **Category** it's assigned to and the **Title** of the photo, if there is one.



4. First, you should know that **anyone** can "vote" for photos that have already been uploaded. This is done from **the Vote button**. It is **not necessary** to have a registration for this.



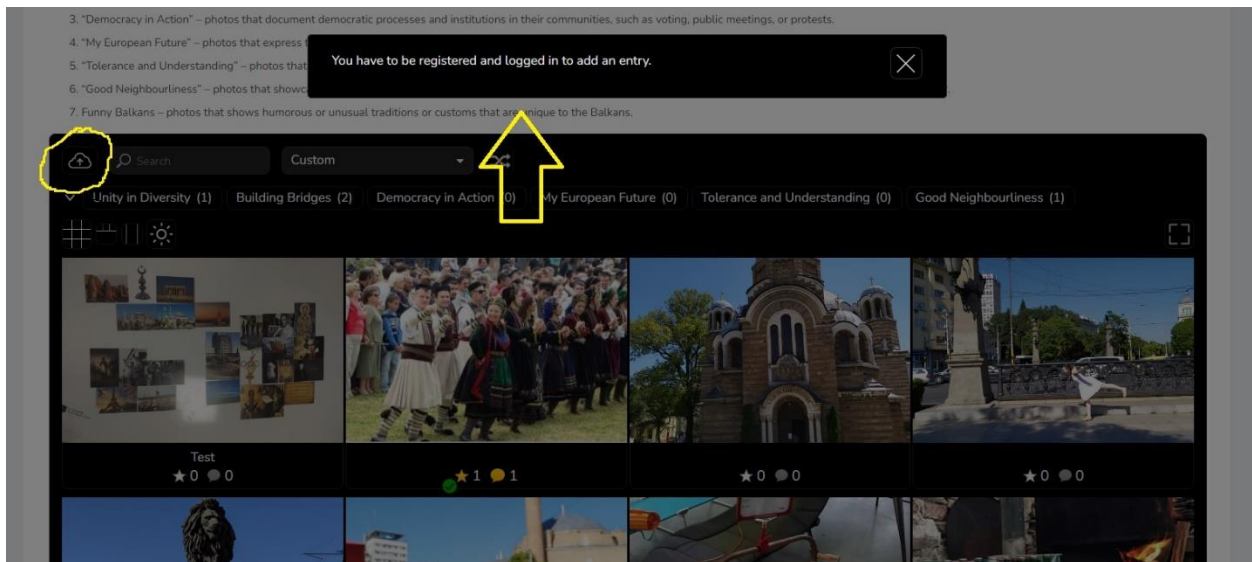
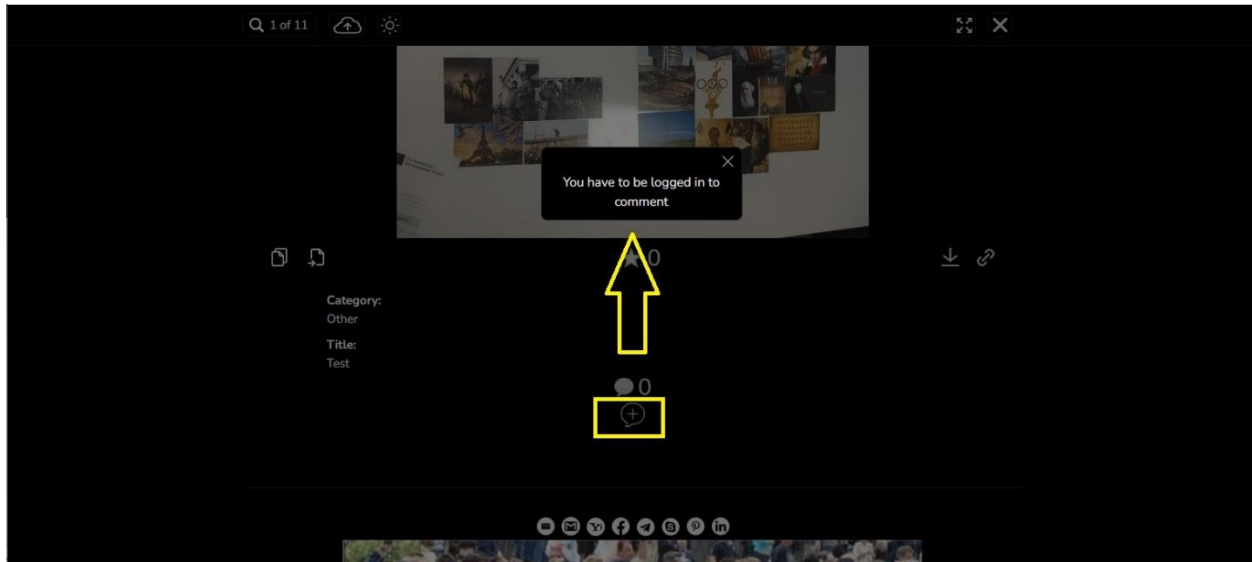

The image of the Balkans

The image of the BALKANS – a set of photographs showing different aspects of life in the Balkans will be created, with instructions for use and starting points for discussion developed for each.

1. "Unity in Diversity" – photos that showcase the diversity of cultures, languages, and traditions in the Balkans while also highlighting how these differences can bring people together.
2. "Building Bridges" – photos that represent efforts to promote understanding and cooperation among different communities in the region.
3. "Democracy in Action" – photos that document democratic processes and institutions in their communities, such as voting, public meetings, or protests.
4. "My European Future" – photos that express their hopes and aspirations for the future of the Balkans within the larger European community.
5. "Tolerance and Understanding" – photos that that promote tolerance, respect, and understanding of different people and cultures.
6. "Good Neighbourliness" – photos that showcase examples of good neighbourliness, such as acts of kindness, volunteer work or community events that bring people together.
7. "Funny Balkans" – photos that shows humorous or unusual traditions or customs that are unique to the Balkans.

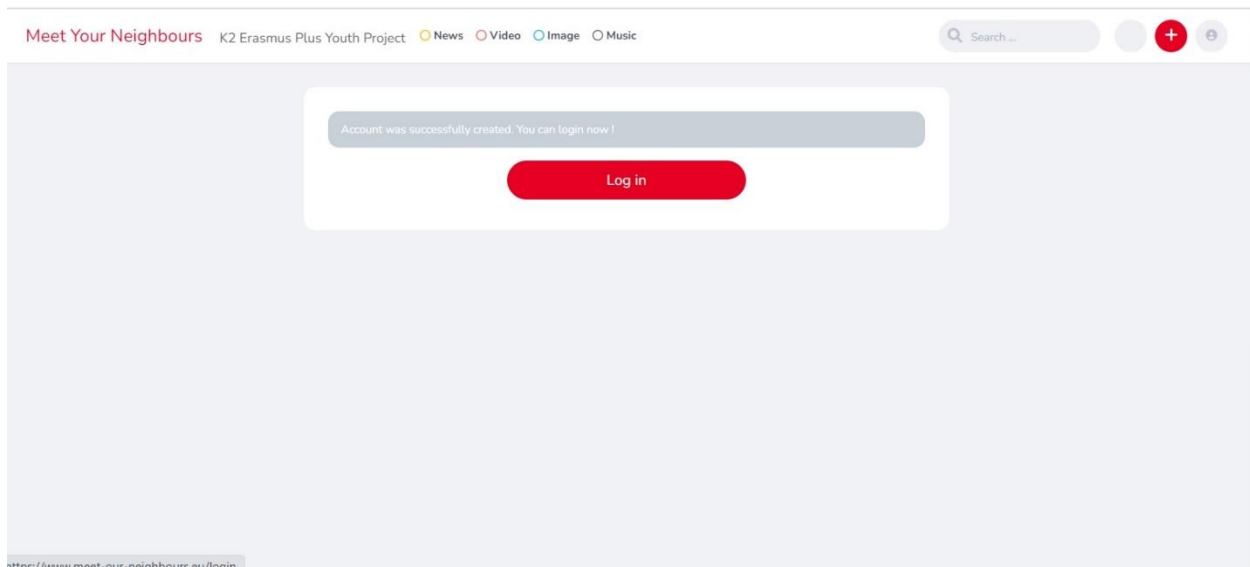

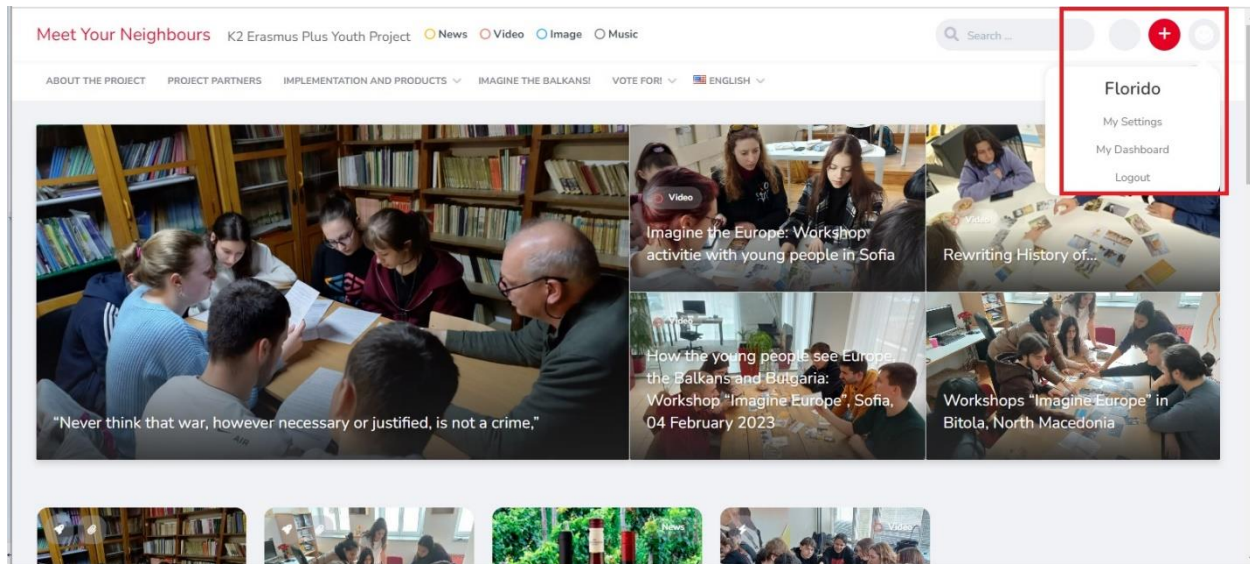

- Once you are in you have the option to **edit your account** from here.



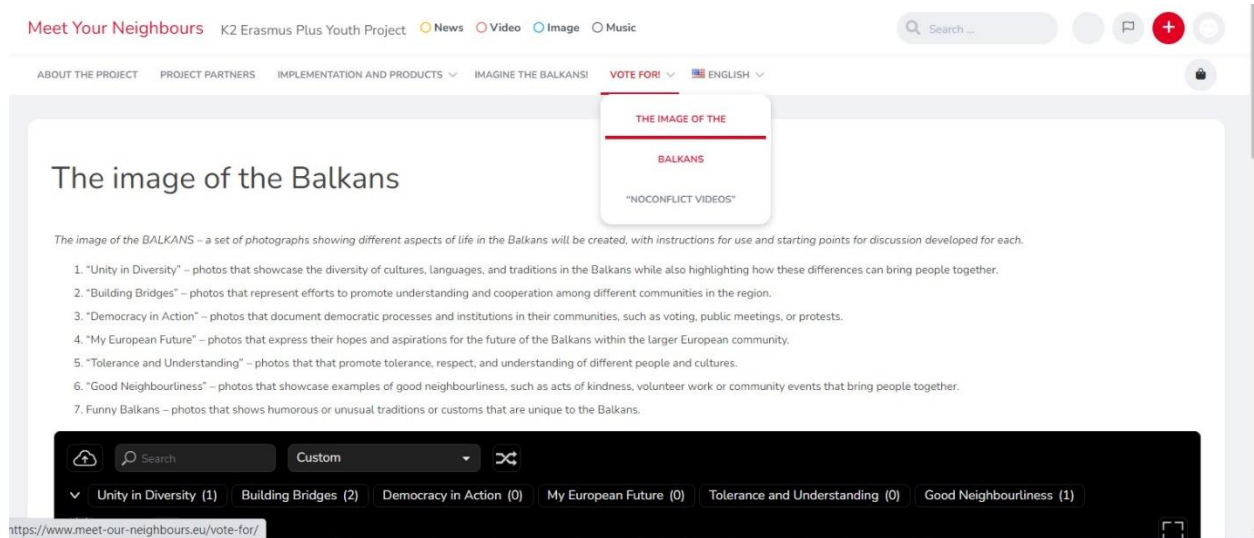

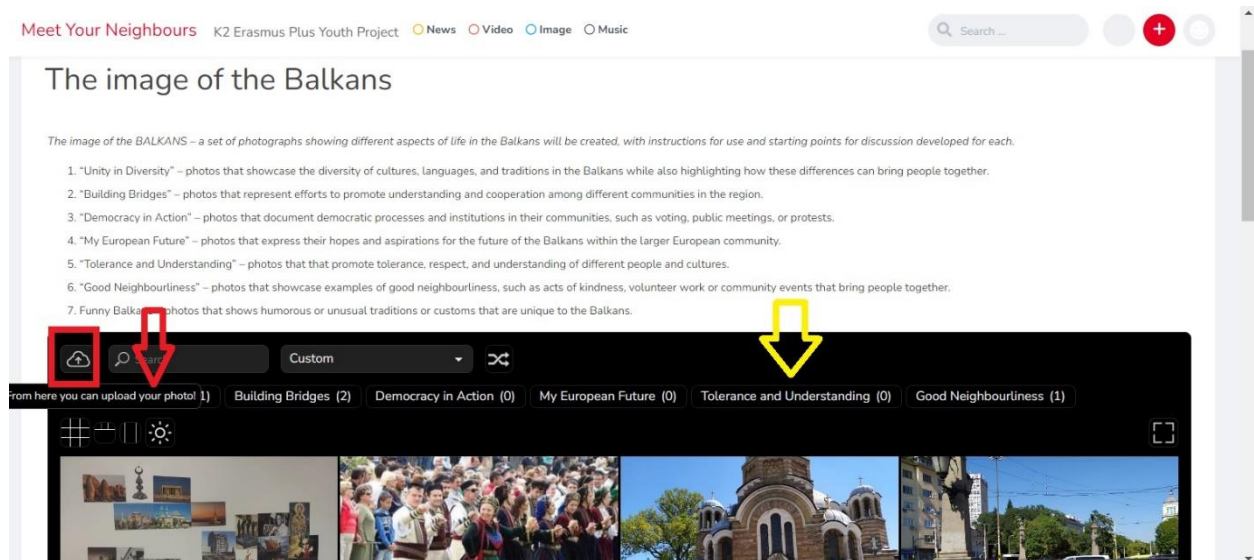

8. In the upper left corner you will see the button to upload photos, and horizontally the categories in which photos can be uploaded and the number of photos already uploaded in each category.





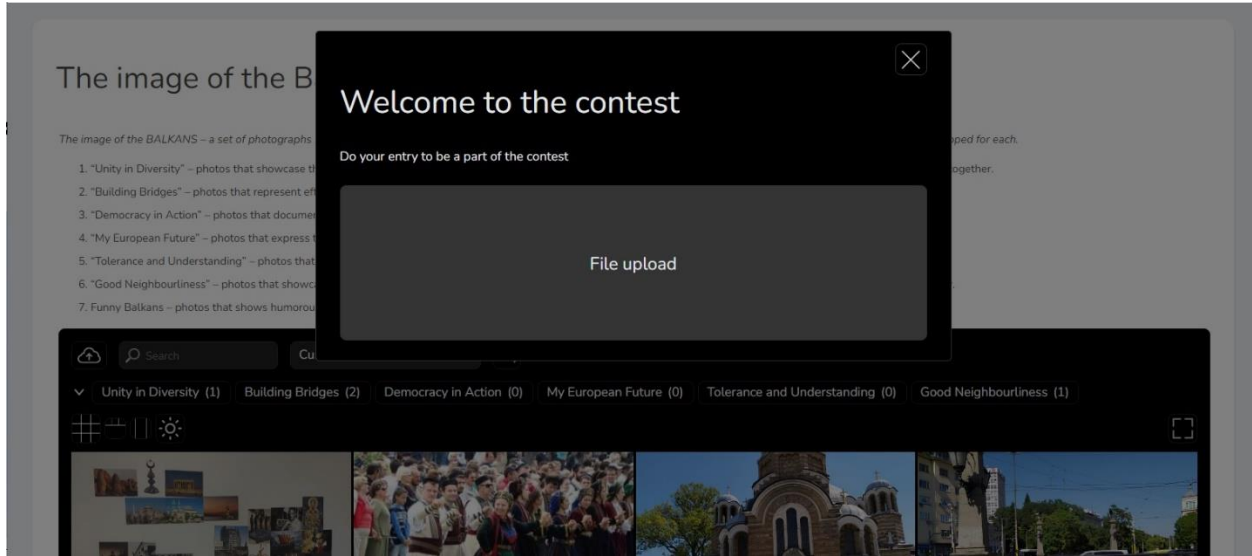

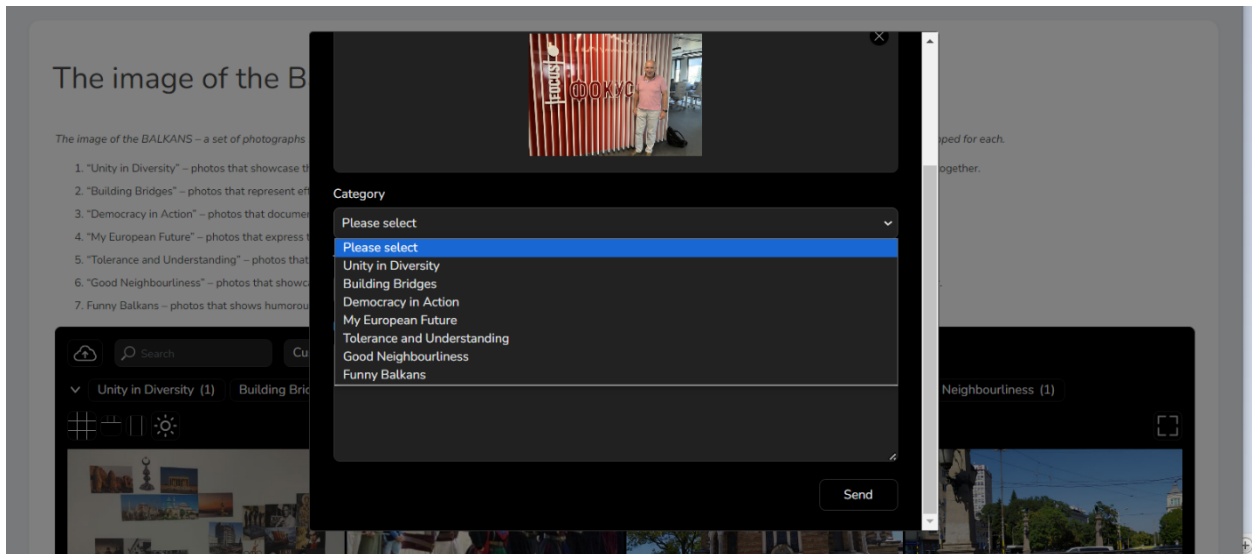

- **Next**, you will be **mandatory to select the category** of the contest you are placing it in.



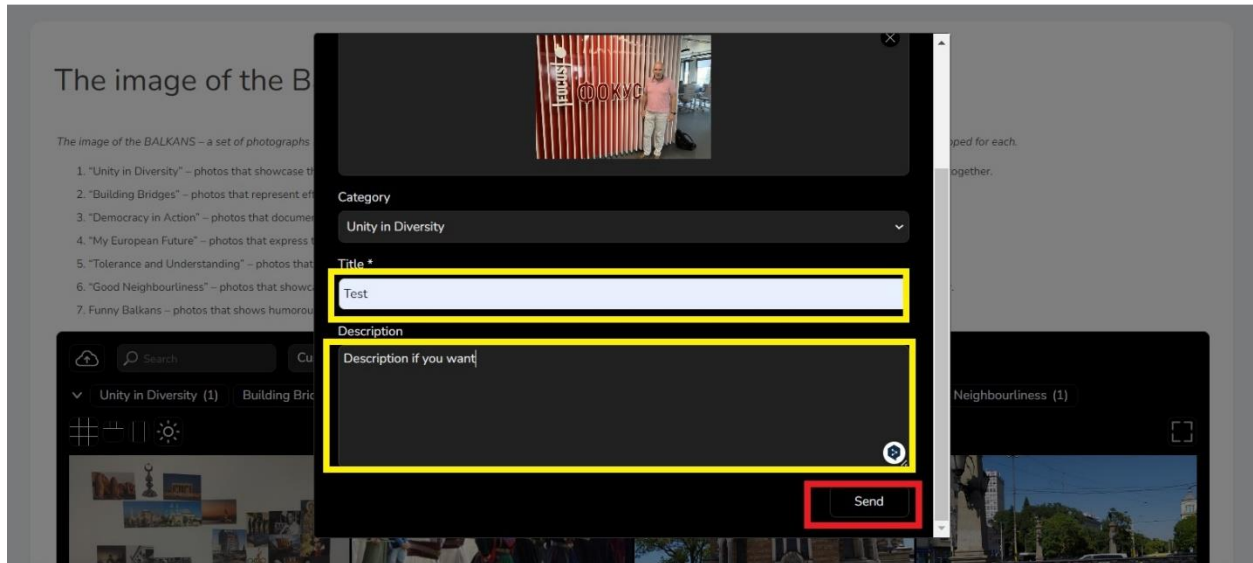

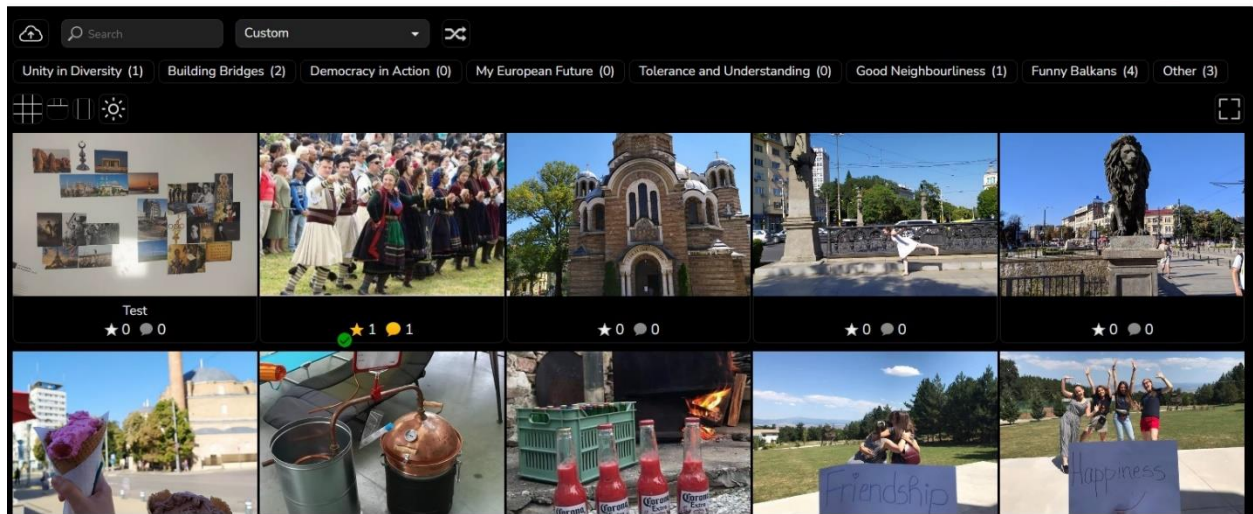
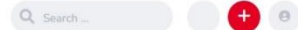
